AEO is seeking a Senior Director to lead its newly formed Department of Data & Analytics (DDA). The Senior Director is an exciting new role that will create a strong bridge between DDA and AEO's Innovation Hub and other departments. As a member of the management team, the Senior Director is accountable for leadership in all tech-enabled programs and assumes the primary technical and data leadership role within AEO. This role will use insights from our proprietary data to identify opportunities for research and programmatic initiatives. The Senior Director also oversees strategy development for AEO subsidiaries and looks across the organization for monetization opportunities, particularly using AEO's proprietary data. The Senior Director is accountable for defining, leading and communicating the technical architecture strategy, plan and operational strategy that support the organization's data, tech-enabled solutions and other related business strategies.

The Senior Director is tasked with building and leading a team to launch and sustain an Enterprise-Wide data strategy. Critically, this data strategy will align with the organization's research, technology, and innovation strategies as well as its overall mission. The Senior Director, while leading the Enterprise-Wide Technology Task Force, will define, maintain and govern the data and technology architectural strategy for our suite of products, services and solutions and work collaboratively with research, innovation and all other functional departments to champion these initiatives.

The Senior Director will drive best practices and direct the creation of an enterprise-wide technology plan and strategy that defines technical architecture, foresees future enterprise platform needs, and delivers an efficient digital and information technology environment.

Crucially, the Senior Director must also be capable of intuitively recognizing connections between AEO's various projects, the small business landscape, and potential monetization opportunities available to AEO. The Senior Director reports to the President & CEO.

Primary Responsibilities

- **Work collaboratively across the organization:**
 - Operates across organizational and computing silos to drive common approaches and highlights information assets and processes across the organization.
 - Regularly partners with AEO's Research Director to identify and solve for data requests, needs, and demands related to ongoing and future research projects.
 - Provides consultation in their area of expertise and facilitates institutional working groups and committees.
 - Collaborates with leaders across the organization to assist in the development of roadmaps that translate business requirements into technological solutions, including timelines, budgets, team structure and skillset requirements.
 - Evaluates connections between AEO projects (and underlying data) and potential future monetization possibilities.
 - Manages and facilitates a Technology Task Force to advise on technology strategy and proposals.
- **Data Architecture and Governance:**
 - Coordinates the development of a data architecture that meets the organization/department business needs and provides an efficient and secure data environment.
 - Designs and effectively communicates an architectural vision by aligning product/program needs, stakeholder requirements/use cases and future capability demands.
 - Leads the design and modeling of tactical and scalable data architectures for delivery, development, and support of projects.
 - Develops and maintains data governance policies, standards, and guidelines to ensure that a consistent framework is applied across the organization.
- **Data Strategy:**
 - Influences and facilitates digital data strategy decisions through consultation and support of the overall business strategy.
 - Facilitates collaboration with internal and external users of AEO research and data through planning sessions, needs analysis and risk assessments, and proposes potential ways to meet needs and requirements.
 - Work collaboratively with the research department to maximize the impact of AEO's data-driven research.
